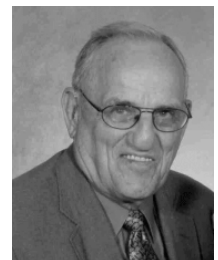
The revival will be held at Friendship General Baptist Church and services will be Wednesday thru Friday at 7:00pm each night.
