Keep Busy For The Lord - Nehemiah 4:6; 6:1-9

Here in Nehemiah we see the people rebuilding the wall in the city of Jerusalem. Nehemiah 4:6, says, "... for the people had a mind to work."

They were ridiculed and mocked but because they had made up their mind what they were going to do they just kept working and ignored those who were trying to cause the work to cease. If the Church members in the Churches today could learn this lesson we could see much done for the cause of Christ. We are so busy fighting everyone else that we don't get the job done in our Churches. Get busy for the Lord and ignore those who are trying to slow you down or stop the work.

In Nehemiah 6, we see the work is continuing and the enemy cannot stop it so they suggest a meeting. Their motive was to stop the work or delay the work. They

might have thought if they could get Nehemiah off the wall maybe others would cease to work. Nehemiah was smart because he told them that he couldn't come down and let the work cease.

Pray for God to strengthen your hands as you faithfully do His work.

As the people listened to Nehemiah things were going good. Nehemiah saw that their opposition was bringing fear among the people saying that their hands would become weak from the work. In verse 9 of chapter 6, Nehemiah prays, "... Now therefore, O God strengthen my hands."

Those that oppose us are only trying to slow down God's work. The only way we can stop them is to keep busy and don't let them discourage us. We must follow God's leading and the people in the Church must follow their

Pastor in not allowing the work to cease.

If every Christian would learn that the key to successful Church building is to keep busy doing God's work, we could see much more accomplished for our Lord.
