For anyone new to this, here is some information concerning this project. Franklin Graham is President of Operation Christmas Shoe Box. These shoeboxes are sent overseas, as well as, to parts of the United States.

Anyone wishing to participate in this project is asked to use a shoebox (you provide or one will be

provided at a later date). You decide whether you want to buy for a boy or girl and the child's age category: 2-4, 5-9 or 10-14. For ideas as of what to purchase there are brochures on the table in the vestibule that gives suggestions and also in that brochure is a form to mark whether you are purchasing for a boy or girl and age. You are, also, asked to donate \$7 which helps to cover shipping costs. Everything you need for your shoe box is in the brochure. You may wrap

your shoebox if you desire but is not necessary. If you wrap the shoebox the lid needs to be wrapped separately. Deadline for shoeboxes to be turned in will probably be around the 2<sup>nd</sup> week of November. Exact date to be determined later.
